[16] Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.”* If you are sick, you are to call _____; they are to _____ over you, and anoint you with _____ in the name of the Lord. 9. Read John 4:46-54. *“So Jesus came again into Cana of Galilee, where he made the water wine. And there was a certain nobleman, whose son was sick at Capernaum. [47] When he heard that Jesus was come out of Judaea into Galilee, he went unto him, and besought him that he would come down, and heal his son: for he was at the point of death. [48] Then said Jesus unto him, Except ye see signs and wonders, ye will not believe. [49] The nobleman saith unto him, Sir, come down ere my child die. [50] Jesus saith unto him, Go thy way; thy son liveth. And the man believed the word that Jesus had spoken unto him, and he went his way. [51] And as he was now going down, his servants met him, and told him, saying, Thy son liveth. [52] Then enquired he of them the hour when he began to amend. And they said unto him, Yesterday at the seventh hour the fever left him. [53] So the father knew that it was at the same hour, in the which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house. 8. Read James 5:16, and John 5:14. Confess your **faults** one to another, and **pray** one for another, that ye may be **healed**.
9. Read John 4:46-54. (Verse 50) And the man **believed** the **word** that Jesus had spoken unto him. (Verse 53) So the father knew that it was at the **same hour** (or exact time), in which Jesus said unto him, Thy son liveth: and himself believed, and his whole house (that is, his whole household) believed on Jesus because of this miracle of healing.
10. Read 1 John 3:8. Jesus Christ, God's Son, appeared that He might destroy the **works of the devil**.
11. Read Acts 10:38. Jesus went about doing good and **healing** all that were **oppressed of the devil**.
12. Read James 4:7. What two things are we to do when we find ourselves being oppressed by the devil? **Submit ourselves to God** and **resist the devil (actively stand against him and his works)**.
13. Read Matthew 14:36. As many as **touched** Jesus were made perfectly whole. Have you touched Jesus today? _____.
