



5 MINUTE LESSONS ON THE KINGDOM OF GOD

Something Personal, Not Just a Theory!

Have you ever watched a movie and then had crazy dreams that night? Have you ever watched something on the internet that you shouldn't and then had bad dreams that evening?

Jesus gave us a principle,

³⁴Your eye is the lamp of your body; when your eye (your conscience) is sound and fulfilling its office, your whole body is full of light; but when it is not sound and is not fulfilling its office, your body is full of darkness.

³⁵Be careful, therefore, that the light that is in you is not darkness."

(Luke 11:34-35 Amplified Bible)

I was on a train traveling in England. I knew I had about an hour before I would reach my destination. I decided to deliberately concentrate on the Lord in prayer before I reached my destination. I sure am glad I did, because the devil was waiting for me at the end of that train ride. When I arrived, some friends I was staying with picked me up at the station. (Colossians 3:5 Holman Christian Standard Bible)

To do this you must always be ready and never give up. Always pray for all God’s people.” (Ephesians 6:10-18 New Century Version)
