

5 MINUTE LESSONS ON THE KINGDOM OF GOD Sorry About Your Loss

Each morning I try to start my day by drawing on the resources of Christ to fulfill God's purpose and will for that day. It starts with something like this: I invite the Father (James 4:8), the Son (Ephesians 3:17, Galatians 2:20) and the Holy Spirit to dwell in my heart by faith and fulfill His purpose for that day (Matthew 7:21). In this way, it will be God's will and purpose being done as I put off the old man and his evil deeds and put on the new man, which after God, is created in righteousness and true holiness (Ephesians 4:22, 24). She picked out a pink angel on a keyring and then saw another one that she liked very much. I said, "You can have them both." Then she told me that this act of kindness was appreciated greatly because she had just lost her father a few weeks ago. I said, "Let's get him an angel in honor of his life. What was his favorite color?" She said, "Blue." I reached into my box and pulled out a beautiful blue angel.

With tears she was so grateful. I had just given her three angels that had great spiritual significance to her.

Then as I turned to go she said, "What is your name?" I said, "Don." Then her tears turned to sobs as she said, "That was my father's name." Then I hugged her and said, "I am sorry for your loss." Then I was gone.

I am learning to step back and see the salvation of God. It's not what I think. What do people perceive? What do they take away from these encounters? I listen as they tell me, "Are you an angel?", "Can I have a hug?", "Can I have a selfie picture with you?", "This is so kind, sweet, beautiful", "Keep spreading His love around", etc. It's God they perceive, not me.
